Helsinki Airport is one of the leading transfer hubs in Europe. Due to its convenient geographic location, the airport provides the fastest connections for the increasing traffic between Europe and Asia.

As a growing number of passengers choose to make their connection via Helsinki, the airport is constantly improving its services to ensure a smooth passenger experience.

Helsinki Airport is known for its modern feel, design-consciousness and efficiency. It has won a number of awards for its smooth connections, baggage delivery, security processing, lounges and sleeping opportunities, among others.

In 2014, the airport launched an extensive development programme, which will increase its passenger capacity to 20 million by 2020, and improve the selection

of services to better cater to passengers' changing needs.

The airport first opened for the 1952 Summer Olympic Games and has seen the growth of the Finnish aviation industry in its over sixty years of operation. It is the largest airport in Finland, connecting the country to the rest of the world through its extensive network of regional airports.




10,000 parking spaces, and an online booking service.

35 automatic border control gates, 60 check-in kiosks and 14 bag drop automates.




Free Wi-Fi for all passengers. No registrations or passwords needed.
